

## General Medicine Residency Curricular Items:

1. Giving an organized, succinct, appropriately complete and focused oral case presentation

2. Writing a meaningful consult request, clear statement of question and appropriate use of consultants

3. Discharge planning and follow up care

4. Patient education

Presentation, differential, evaluation and management of patients with:

5. Diabetes

6. DVT, cellulitis and leg ulcers

7. UTI, pyelonephritis and renal calculus disease

8. Congestive heart failure

9. Sickle cell disease

10. Pneumonia

11. Anemia including hemolytic anemia

12. Ascites, jaundice, abdominal pain or diarrhea including diverticulosis, diverticulitis, pancreatitis, cholelithiasis and ischemic bowel

13. GI bleed

14. Hypertension

15. Recognition of dermatologic manifestations and management of drug allergy

16. Careful attention to and diagnosis of skin lesions and rashes

17. Application of evidence from the current medical literature
